

Memorandum of Understanding

Memorandum of Understanding

between

Nadi Town Council and North Shore City Council

In order to promote co-operation and the advancement of service delivered to ratepayers and visitors, the Nadi Town Council and the North Shore City Council as two separate public bodies with a common purpose agree that, within fields that are mutually acceptable, the following general forms of co-operation will be pursued:

- Expertise advice
- Human resources development including the specific headers:
 - sharing of technical ideas
 - exchange of personnel and secondment of Council officers for work experience or assistance with accommodation and expenses to be negotiated
 - delegation visits
- Assistance in acquiring infrastructure equipment and machinery
- Participation in seminars
- Development of public amenities
- Other issues of common interest

Recitals

The purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding is only to express the intentions of the Parties and is not intended to be legally binding on either party. The terms of co-operation for each specific activity contemplated under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity. Any such activities agreed upon will be recorded and governed by a separate legally binding agreement executed by both parties. Each institution shall designate a liaison officer to develop and co-ordinate the specific activities agreed upon. This Memorandum of Understanding imposes no financial obligations on either party. Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds. This Memorandum of Understanding will remain current indefinitely with the understanding that either party may terminate it by giving the other party twelve months' written notice, unless an earlier termination is mutually agreed upon. Each party recognises that the other party has, may have, or will have arrangements of a similar or different nature with other institutions whether in each party's respective countries or elsewhere in the world, during the currency of this Memorandum of Understanding. Each party shall not make any public announcement or statement or publish or release any information in relation to any proposed activity or proposed collaboration without the prior written approval of both parties. Each party shall keep confidential any information that it receives from the other party which is marked confidential or which a party notifies the other party is confidential.
